Meeting convened at 7:00 p.m.

Roll call confirmed Commissioners Jack Walton, Gary Lafferty, Patricia Kropp and William Muccino present. Alternate Commissioners Richard Rossi and Michael Brown were also present. Michael Brown filled in for the open commissioners voting spot.

Minutes of October 10, 2012 were approved by William Muccino, Gary Lafferty and Jack Walton. Patricia Kropp and Michael Brown abstained.

Permit application approval for “Santa is Coming to Town” on November 23, 2012 has been issued by DOT. Local police will handle all aspects of traffic and temporary road closures.

Under “New Business” (Agenda 7a) a “no parking sign” was denied on Williams Street in Oakville. Existing law of no parking within 25 feet of an intersection will be enforced. Unanimous vote by five commissioners present.

Also, under “New Business” (Agenda 7b) some version of a “slow children present or at play sign” on Carter Street in Oakville was denied. Federal Highway Administration Uniform Traffic Control does not sanction this type of signage for reasons including the possibility of tort liability. Unanimous vote by five commissioners present.
