Meeting convened at 7:00 p.m.

Roll call included Commissioners Jack Walton, Patricia Kropp, William Muccino, Thomas Walsh and Richard Rossi. Absent commissioners were Michael Brown and Gary Lafferty. Commissioner Richard Rossi filled in for Commissioner Gary Lafferty.

Public participation included an eight person delegation from Wood View Apartments discussing “No Parking” signs on Slade Street. No action was taken.

Agenda Item 4, “Minutes” of March 13, 2013, was approved by five commissioners present.

Correspondence from senior center requesting “Slow Senior Center” signs installation on Falls Avenue was added to the agenda as 7b by a “Yes” vote from five commissioners present.

Agenda Item 6b, “Discussion on Citizen’s Complaints #2012/02-06”, produced no commission action.

Agenda Item 7a on the agenda concerned a request for Sunnyside Avenue, between Buckingham Street and Falls Avenue, to be made one way. The commission felt the present road width was adequate for two-way traffic and, with no alternative roads nearby to accommodate traffic in the opposite direction, one way would be impractical. Five commissioners voted to deny the request.

Agenda Item 7b addition to the agenda, add “Slow Senior Center” signs on Falls Avenue, adjacent to the Oakville Senior Center, was approved by the five commissioners present.

Agenda Item 10, “Adjournment”, occurred at 7:55 p.m. by unanimous commission affirmative vote.
